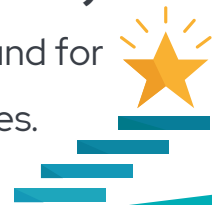
## What is the EFIF?

A one-time financial support for immigrant families who need help.

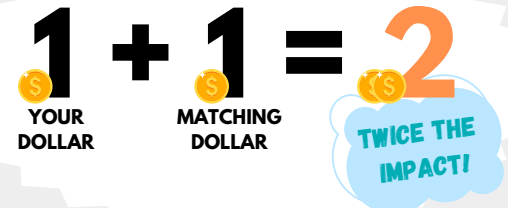

## What is our goal?

To have at least 200 supporting community members make an annual donation of **\$52 (only \$1 per week)** to the Emergency Fund for Immigrant Families.

## What are the requirements to request help?

- Must reside in Clinton County
- Be an immigrant
- Have immediate expenses that are due within the next week or past due
- Request help only once per family/household

## What can EFIF help with?

- Rent/mortgage
- Public services/utilities
- Groceries
- Medical bills (Assistance must be requested through the hospital/clinic first.)



## What is the application process?

1. The family needs to fill out an application and submit it before noon on Tuesdays.
2. The 5-organization committee reviews applications on Wednesday mornings and determines whether the application can be approved in its entirety, in part, or not approved.
3. The committee's decision is communicated to families on Thursday afternoons.
4. If an application is approved, payment is made by check directly to the agency or landlord and mailed by Friday of that week.

## Responsible Fund Administration Practices

- Families are allowed to apply for help only once.
- Confirmation of what is owed & payment history is made with the agencies/landlords .
- Proof is required for applicants asking for help with a medical expense.
